

# Boaz

## Please join us in praying;

- Breakthrough for those who have been in limbo for many months or years waiting for a positive decision on a fresh claim.
- That all clients are given the strength to deal with the struggles they face daily (financial hardship, separation from family, physical and mental health issues, stigma, boredom and frustration, language barriers). And that those on our waiting list find some sort of safety and comfort.
- For those who don't know Christ to come into strong relationship with him.
- For those refugees who have been granted leave to remain—that they may be able to find education, training and employment, and be able to integrate and truly fulfill their potential.
- For all the trustees, staff and volunteers. For the faith and strength to keep working hard and for wisdom to know how best to serve our clients, for volunteers to continue to have the time and energy to give as much as they do and for hosts, that opening up their homes would continue to be a positive experience.
